



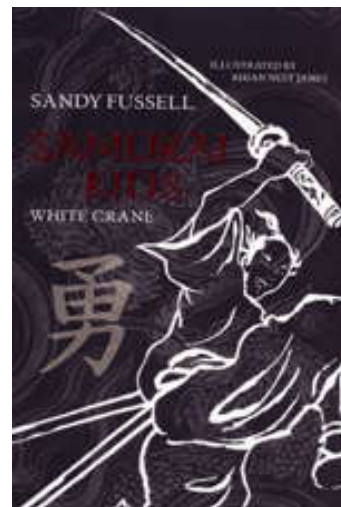
Classroom Ideas (Newsletter 2008/1)

Talking and Listening

Reading
